1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Registration Plates for Individuals with Disabilities –**
3 **Parking in Baltimore County**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing an individual for whom special registration plates for
5 individuals with disabilities are issued to park in a designated zone for the
6 handicapped established by Baltimore County on any county road, subject to a
7 certain restriction; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to parking
8 in Baltimore County and special registration plates for individuals with
9 disabilities.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Transportation**

18 13–616.

1 (f) (2) The person for whom special registration plates are issued under
2 this section or under a similar provision of any other state or country:

3 (i) 1. Except as provided in items (ii) and (iii) of this
4 paragraph, may park for unlimited periods in parking zones restricted as to the length
5 of parking time permitted; and

6 2. Is not required to pay any parking meter fees of this
7 State or of any political subdivision of this State where parking meters do not meet the
8 requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act;

9 (ii) May park in a parking space equipped with a parking meter
10 only for:

11 1. Except as provided in item [(ii)2] 2 of this
12 [paragraph] ITEM, twice the maximum time period permitted on the parking meter
13 but not to exceed a maximum of 4 hours; and

14 2. If the parking meter permits parking for more than 4
15 hours, the period permitted on the parking meter; and

16 (iii) Subject to the posted time restriction specified for [this] THE
17 parking zone, may park in a designated zone for the handicapped established [at]:

18 1. AT any State-owned airport; OR

19 2. BY BALTIMORE COUNTY ON ANY COUNTY
20 HIGHWAY.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2013.
