A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

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Harford County Liquor Control Board - Reserve Account

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Reserve Account of the Harford County Liquor 4 Control Board as a special, nonlapsing account; specifying the purpose of the 5 Reserve Account; requiring a designee of the Board to administer the Reserve 6 Account; requiring the Board to hold the Reserve Account separately and account for the Reserve Account; specifying the contents of the Reserve Account; 7 8 specifying a certain maximum amount that is payable annually into the 9 Reserve Account; specifying the circumstances under which expenditures from the Reserve Account may occur; stating a certain maximum amount that the 10 Reserve Account may hold at any time; requiring that fines imposed or 11 12recognizances forfeited for certain violations be payable to the Board; defining 13 certain terms; making certain stylistic changes; clarifying language; and generally relating to the Reserve Account of the Harford County Liquor Control 14 15 Board.
