(B) THE OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF EACH SWIMMING POOL 1 (1) SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 13-517 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE. 4 (2) THE PROGRAM REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE PROVISIONS THAT ENSURE: AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IS (I) PROVIDED ON-SITE; AND (III) AN INDIVIDUAL TRAINED IN THE OPERATION AND USE OF AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IS PRESENT AT EACH SWIMMING POOL. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE AND THE (C) MARYLAND INSTITUTE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEMS 14 JOINTLY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT: (1) ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR PERIODIC INSPECTIONS AND 15ANNUAL MAINTENANCE OF THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS; AND 16 17(2) ASSIST THE OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF EACH SWIMMING POOL IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
