 - (a) The term of the one member appointed from councilmanic district 5 of Baltimore County whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2013, shall terminate at the end of November 4, 2014, and the Governor shall appoint an additional member to the county board, as authorized under this Act, who shall succeed the member whose term terminated at the end of November 4, 2014, until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and
 - (b) The terms of the six members appointed from councilmanic districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, and 7 of Baltimore County, or their successors, who are in office on the effective date of this Act, shall terminate at the end of December 7, 2014, and the members elected from the school board districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 in Baltimore County, as established in accordance with this Act, at the general election in November 2014, shall succeed those appointed members and serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 8, 2014, until a successor is elected and qualifies.
 - SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in appointing members to the Baltimore County Board of Education, the Governor shall ensure, to the extent practicable, that the total makeup of the county board reflects gender, ethnic, and racial diversity.
