## Vehicle Laws - Speed Monitoring and Work Zone Speed Control Systems

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "recorded image" for purposes of 4 provisions relating to speed monitoring systems and work zone speed control 5 systems; requiring that certain time-stamped images of a motor vehicle provide 6 sufficient information to allow for the calculation of a certain speed of the motor 7 vehicle; altering a certain requirement relating to the issuance of warnings for 8 certain violations; requiring a local law adopted by the governing body of a local 9 jurisdiction to provide that for a certain period of time after a speed monitoring system is placed in the jurisdiction, any violation recorded by the speed 10 monitoring system may be enforced only by the issuance of a warning; 11 12 prohibiting a contractor's fee from being contingent on the number of citations 13 issued or paid if the contractor administers or processes the citations; requiring a court to impose a certain civil penalty if it finds that a citation for an alleged 14 15 violation recorded by a speed monitoring system or a work zone speed control 16 system was issued erroneously; requiring a civil penalty collected under this Act 17 to be deposited into the Transportation Trust Fund; establishing that an organization that represents the interests of motorists in the State may bring 18 19 an action to enforce certain provisions of law relating to speed monitoring 20 systems and work zone speed control systems in a court of competent 21 jurisdiction; and generally relating to speed monitoring systems and work zone 22 speed control systems.
