- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, this section
applies to a county or municipality that is subject to a national pollutant discharge
elimination system Phase I municipal separate storm sewer system permit.

1 (2) This section does not apply to [a]:

2 (I) A county or municipality that, on or before July 1, 2012, has 3 enacted and implemented a system of charges under § 4–204 of this subtitle for the 4 purpose of funding a watershed protection and restoration program, or similar 5 program, in a manner consistent with the requirements of this section; OR

(II) FREDERICK COUNTY.

7 (b) On or before July 1, 2013, a county or municipality shall adopt and 8 implement local laws or ordinances necessary to establish a watershed protection and 9 restoration program.

10 (c) A watershed protection and restoration program established under this 11 section shall include:

- 12 (1) A stormwater remediation fee; and
- 13 (2) A local watershed protection and restoration fund.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 July 1, 2013.
