11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15	(a) A person may not:
16 17	(1) keep a gaming device, or all or a part of a building, vessel, or place, on land or water within the State for the purpose of gambling;
18 19	(2) own, rent, or occupy all or a part of a building, vessel, or place and knowingly allow a gaming device to be kept in the building, vessel, or place;
20 21	(3) lease or rent all or a part of a building, vessel, or place to be used for the purpose of gambling;

- 1 A person who knows that the person's house or office is being used for the 2 purpose of selling or bartering a lottery device in violation of § 12–203 of this subtitle 3 is deemed to be allowing the house or office to be used for those purposes. 4 (c) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 5 conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding [1 year] 3 YEARS or a fine not 6 exceeding [\$1,000] **\$3,000** or both. 7 12-205.8 This section does not apply to a person who possesses: (a) 9 an item that is prohibited under this section that was obtained to procure or furnish evidence of a violation of this subtitle; or 10 11 (2) a lottery ticket or slip issued by this State or another government. - 24 (a) Except as allowed under §§ 12–304 through 12–306 of this subtitle, a person may not locate, possess, keep, or operate a slot machine in the State as an owner, lessor, lessee, licensor, licensee, or in any other capacity.

(b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding [1 year] **3 YEARS** or a fine of [\$1,000] **\$3,000** or both for each violation.
