Somerset County - Alcoholic Beverages - Selling Near Schools, Places of Worship, Public Libraries, and Youth Centers

FOR the purpose of making certain exceptions to the prohibition against the Somerset
County Board of License Commissioners approving a license to sell alcoholic
beverages for certain establishments located within 300 feet of a school, church
or other place of worship, public library, or youth center; and generally relating
to the issuance of a license to sell alcoholic beverages in Somerset County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

18 (A) (1) [In] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 19 SUBSECTION, IN Somerset County, the Board of License Commissioners may not 20 approve any license to sell alcoholic beverages within a 300 foot measurement from

11 **(B)** This section may not apply to the issuance of special or temporary 12 licenses.
