Employees' Pension System – Somerset County Economic Development Commission – Eligible Governmental Unit

FOR the purpose of adding the Somerset County Economic Development Commission 4 5 as an eligible governmental unit in the Employees' Pension System; providing 6 that certain individuals are not subject to the reformed contributory pension 7 benefit in the Employees' Pension System; providing that certain individuals 8 are subject to the alternate contributory pension benefit in the Employees' 9 Pension System; providing that certain individuals may become subject to the reformed contributory pension benefit in the same manner that an individual 10 who was a member of the Employees' Pension System on a certain date and 11 12 remains a member on a certain date may be subject to the reformed 13 contributory benefit; providing certain employees of the Somerset County Economic Development Commission a certain amount of additional service 14 credit in the Employees' Pension System; prohibiting certain employees of the 15 16 Somerset County Economic Development Commission from receiving a certain 17 amount of additional service credit in the Employees' Pension System; and generally relating to employees of the Somerset County Economic Development 18 19 Commission participating in the Employees' Pension System.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 7 (1) an individual who becomes a member of the Employees' Pension 8 System or the Teachers' Pension System on or after July 1, 2011; and
