- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain water or sewerage service suppliers annually to 4 include with the billing information sent to each customer a bill insert that 5 provides certain information related to dental materials containing mercury; 6 requiring the Department of the Environment to adopt regulations to 7 implement this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to providing
- 8 customers of water and sewerage service suppliers information about dental
- 9 materials containing mercury.

- 7 (2) "LARGE WATER OR SEWERAGE SERVICE SUPPLIER" MEANS 8 ANY PERSON WHO OWNS OR OPERATES A WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OR A 9 SEWERAGE SYSTEM THAT SERVES MORE THAN 100,000 CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS.
