12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (a) Any properly accredited person desiring to assist the Department in the 17 control of wildlife injurious to agriculture or other interests, or to provide care and 18 treatment of sick or injured wildlife for rehabilitation and release back to the wild, 19 shall first obtain a wildlife cooperator permit from the Secretary.

20 (b) (1) The Secretary may issue a wildlife cooperator permit, on the 21 payment of a reasonable fee, to a person who:

(i) Has adequate training in the capture, handling, and care ofwildlife; and
