- 3 (2) (I) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2014, THE STATE BOARD 4 SHALL ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR SOCIAL IMPACT BONDS TO

- 6 THROUGH GRADE 12.
- 7 (II) THE STATE BOARD MAY ISSUE ADDITIONAL REQUESTS 8 FOR PROPOSALS FOR SOCIAL IMPACT BONDS, AS NEEDED.
- 9 (3) A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL 10 INCLUDE:
