20	(1) Passes an appropriate medical examination; and

- 3 (1) IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM OR 4 TRANSPORTATION COMPANY THAT OPERATES THE SCHOOL VEHICLE; AND
- 5 (2) IS IN POSSESSION OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION THAT 6 IDENTIFIES THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM OR TRANSPORTATION COMPANY THAT 7 EMPLOYS THE INDIVIDUAL AS A SCHOOL VEHICLE ON–BOARD ATTENDANT.
- 8 [(b)] (C) With the advice of the State Department of Education, the 9 Administration may adopt regulations concerning the qualifications of school vehicle 10 drivers AND SCHOOL VEHICLE ON-BOARD ATTENDANTS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
