5 FOR the purpose of requiring a student to complete an online course to graduate from 6 high school, beginning with students entering a certain grade in a certain school 7 year; requiring that certain online courses be approved by the State Department of Education or the local county board of education; and generally relating to 8 9 high school graduation requirements in the State establishing additional 10 responsibilities for the Maryland Advisory Council for Virtual Learning; requiring the Advisory Council to study and make recommendations regarding 11 certain matters; requiring the Advisory Council to report certain findings and 12 recommendations to the State Superintendent of Education and certain 13 committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for 14 15 the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Maryland Advisory Council for Virtual Learning. 16

30 31 32 33	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October June 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
