- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
 18 EDUCATION THAT RECEIVES FUNDING FROM TO A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER
- 19 EDUCATION INSTITUTION AND A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE STATE.

(B) (1) FOR BEGINNING IN THE 2014–2015 ACADEMIC YEAR, FOR ALL FIRST TIME, FULL—TIME UNDERGRADUATE FRESHMEN, AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL MAIL PROVIDE TO THE STUDENT; INFORMATION OF THE COST OF HIGHER EDUCATION AT THE INSTITUTION BY COMPLETING AND MAILING OR PROVIDING ELECTRONICALLY, AT MINIMUM, THE INFORMATION CONTAINED ON THE FORM KNOWN AS THE FINANCIAL AID SHOPPING SHEET AS PROMULGATED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.
(2) THE FINANCIAL AID SHOPPING SHEET SHALL BE MAILED OF PROVIDED ELECTRONICALLY TO THE STUDENT AT THE SAME TIME THAT AN AWARD OF FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID IS MAILED OR PROVIDED ELECTRONICALLY TO THE STUDENT.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectively 1, 2013.
