Election Law – Reporting of Precinct Results

FOR the purpose of requiring a local board of canvassers to prepare a statement of
election results by precinct that includes all votes cast by voters registered in
each precinct who voted provisionally, absentee, and early on certain voting
<u>machines</u>; requiring the State Board of Elections to prepare a report that
includes election results by precinct of all votes cast by voters registered in each
precinct who voted provisionally, absentee, and early on certain voting
machines; and generally relating to the reporting of election results.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

HOUSE BILL 592

1 (a) Unless otherwise provided by the Maryland Constitution, and except as 2 provided in subsection (b) of this section, each board of canvassers shall prepare a 3 statement of election results by precinct for each candidate or question voted on at the 4 election and declare:

- 5 (1) who is elected or nominated for office:
- 6

(i) in county government; or

(ii) for any other office voted for only within that county, if the
certificate of candidacy for that office was issued by the local board; and

- 9 (2) whether or not a question is adopted or approved.
- 10 (b) The statement prepared by the board of canvassers under this section:
- 11

(1) may not report the absentee vote separately by precinct; AND

12 (2) SHALL REPORT ELECTION RESULTS BY PRECINCT FOR EACH 13 CANDIDATE OR QUESTION VOTED ON AT THE ELECTION THAT INCLUDE ALL 14 VOTES CAST BY VOTERS REGISTERED IN EACH PRECINCT WHO VOTED 15 PROVISIONALLY, ABSENTEE, AND EARLY ON DIRECT RECORDING ELECTRONIC 16 VOTING MACHINES.

17 (c) Each local board shall publish a sufficient number of copies of the 18 complete election results, tabulated by precinct, and shall make the copies available to 19 the public at cost.

20 (d) (1) In addition to the statement of election results specified under 21 subsection (a) of this section, the State Board shall make available in an electronic 22 format a report of election results for each candidate or question voted on at the 23 election:

24 (i) by precinct, INCLUDING ALL VOTES CAST BY VOTERS
 25 REGISTERED IN EACH PRECINCT WHO VOTED PROVISIONALLY, ABSENTEE, AND
 26 EARLY ON DIRECT RECORDING ELECTRONIC VOTING MACHINES;

- (ii) by State legislative district, including any subdistrict;
- 28 (iii) by county legislative district; and
- 29 (iv) for each county as a whole.

30 (2) The State Board may make the report specified under paragraph31 (1) of this subsection available to the public at cost.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 June 1, 2013.
