18 (b) (1) **(I)** The Secretary of Budget and Management, with the 19 assistance of the Secretary, shall develop and implement a plan for hiring current and 20 former recipients, children of current or former recipients, foster youth, and obligors 21 by the principal departments within the Executive Branch of State government.
