BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Public Utilities 4 20-207.5 6 By [September 15] OCTOBER 31 of each year, the Commission shall 7 issue a report to the Montgomery County and Prince George's County Senate and 8 House Delegations to the Maryland General Assembly concerning: 9 the implementation and administration of the minority business (1) enterprise programs under this subtitle for the fiscal year ending on the preceding 10 June 30; and 11 12 **(2)** appropriate recommendations concerning the programs. 13 (b) (1) The Commission may conduct an impartial fact-finding study in connection with a minority business enterprise program for consistency with 14 applicable law. 15 16 (2)The Commission shall report the findings of a study completed 17 under this subsection to the Montgomery County and Prince George's County Senate 18 and House Delegations to the Maryland General Assembly. 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 20 read as follows: 21Chapter 685 of the Acts of 2012 22SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That: On or before December 31, [2012,] 2013, the Task Force shall report its 23 (h) 24findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the Montgomery County and Prince George's County 25delegations to the General Assembly. 26 27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2012. Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] 2 28YEARS and, at the end of May 31, [2013,] 2014, with no further action required by the 29 General Assembly, Section 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and 30 effect. 31
