4	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC ACCESS POINT" INCLUDES A PARKING
5	LOT, PLAYGROUND, PICNIC AREA, BOAT LAUNCHING RAMP, OR PARK.
6	(B) THE WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER A LEAK IS REPORTED, THE
7	COMMISSION SHALL POST WARNING SIGNS AT EACH PUBLIC ACCESS POINT TO A
8	WATERWAY THAT BECOMES CONTAMINATED BY A LEAK IN A SANITARY SEWER

19	(2) IS NOT REQUIRED TO POST ANY WARNING SIGN UPSTREAM
20	FROM A LEAK.
21	(E) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT
22	THIS SECTION, INCLUDING REGULATIONS CONCERNING:
23	(1) THE MINIMUM DISTANCE FROM THE SOURCE OF A LEAK
24	WITHIN WHICH WARNING SIGNS MUST BE POSTED; AND
25	(2) THE FORM AND CONTENT OF THE WARNING SIGNS.
