## 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(a) The Administration shall ensure that the driver's license or identification
 card of an applicant [who presents a certification of veteran status obtained from the
 Department of Veterans Affairs in accordance with § 9–905 of the State Government
 Article, a DD Form 214, or other documentation acceptable to the Administration
 certifying veteran status,] includes a notation indicating that the applicant is a
 veteran IF THE APPLICANT PRESENTS DOCUMENTATION ACCEPTABLE TO THE
 ADMINISTRATION CERTIFYING VETERAN STATUS, INCLUDING:

1 (1) A CERTIFICATION OF VETERAN STATUS OBTAINED FROM THE 2 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 9–905 OF THE 3 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE;

4 (2) A DD FORM 214; OR

5 (3) A VALID MILITARY IDENTIFICATION CARD FOR ACTIVE DUTY 6 OR RETIRED MILITARY PERSONNEL.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect8 October 1, 2013.
