## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Board of Education – Compensation**

3 **MC 8–13**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the compensation received by the president and elected  
5 members of the Montgomery County Board of Education; providing that this Act  
6 does not apply to the salary or compensation of the president and members of  
7 the board during a certain term of office; and generally relating to the  
8 Montgomery County Board of Education.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article – Education  
11 Section 3–902  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 3–902.

18 (a) An elected member of the county board is entitled to reimbursement for  
19 travel and other expenses as provided by the Montgomery County Council.

1 (b) (1) An elected member of the county board is entitled to receive  
2 **[\$18,500] \$25,000** annually as compensation and the president of the county board is  
3 entitled to an additional \$4,000 annually as compensation.

4 (2) An elected member is entitled to health insurance and to other  
5 fringe benefits regularly provided to employees of the board of education under the  
6 same terms and conditions extended to other employees of the board of education.

7 (c) (1) The student member may not receive compensation but, after  
8 submitting expense vouchers, may be reimbursed for out-of-pocket expenses incurred  
9 in connection with official duties.

10 (2) A student member who completes a full term on the board shall be  
11 granted a scholarship of \$5,000 to be applied toward the student's higher education  
12 costs.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §  
14 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to  
15 the salary or compensation of the president and members of the Montgomery County  
16 Board of Education during a term of office beginning before the effective date of this  
17 Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the  
18 president and members of the Montgomery County Board of Education shall take  
19 effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

20 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 July 1, 2013.
