14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 19	(a) An elected member of the county board is entitled to reimbursement for travel and other expenses as provided by the Montgomery County Council.
20 21 22	(b) (1) An elected member of the county board is entitled to receive [\$18,500] \$25,000 annually as compensation and the president of the county board is entitled to an additional \$4,000 annually as compensation.

- 1 (2) An elected member is entitled to health insurance and to other 2 fringe benefits regularly provided to employees of the board of education under the 3 same terms and conditions extended to other employees of the board of education.
 - (c) (1) The student member may not receive compensation but, after submitting expense vouchers, may be reimbursed for out—of—pocket expenses incurred in connection with official duties.
- 7 (2) A student member who completes a full term on the board shall be 8 granted a scholarship of \$5,000 to be applied toward the student's higher education 9 costs.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the president and members of the Montgomery County Board of Education during a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the president and members of the Montgomery County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
