# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

### **Tobacco–Free Schools Act**

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of tobacco products in school buildings, on
  school grounds, and inside school buses; prohibiting the use of tobacco products
  by certain persons at certain school-sponsored events; providing a penalty for a
  violation; requiring the State Department of Education to adopt certain
  regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the use of tobacco
  products at schools.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 19 MEANINGS INDICATED.

20 (2) "OFF-CAMPUS, SCHOOL-SPONSORED EVENT" MEANS AN
21 EVENT SPONSORED BY A SCHOOL THAT IS NOT IN A SCHOOL BUILDING OR ON
22 SCHOOL GROUNDS.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



#### HOUSE BILL 684

1 (3) "SCHOOL BUILDING" MEANS A BUILDING OWNED OR LEASED 2 BY A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM, A PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL, OR A PRIVATE 3 SCHOOL.

4 (4) "SCHOOL BUS" MEANS ANY VEHICLE OWNED BY A LOCAL 5 SCHOOL SYSTEM, A PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL, OR A PRIVATE SCHOOL THAT IS 6 USED TO TRANSPORT STUDENTS.

7 (5) "SCHOOL GROUNDS" MEANS LAND THAT SURROUNDS A
8 SCHOOL BUILDING THAT IS OWNED OR LEASED BY A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM, A
9 PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL, OR A PRIVATE SCHOOL.

10 (6) (I) "TOBACCO PRODUCT" MEANS ANY PRODUCT DERIVED 11 FROM THE TOBACCO PLANT THAT IS SMOKED, CHEWED, SNIFFED, OR 12 OTHERWISE CONSUMED.

- 13 (II) "TOBACCO PRODUCT" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
- 14 **1. NICOTINE REPLACEMENT THERAPY; OR**

152.ATOBACCOPRODUCTUSEDFOR16DEMONSTRATION PURPOSES IN ANTISMOKING OR DRUG EDUCATION CLASSES.

## 17 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT USE A TOBACCO PRODUCT AT ANY TIME 18 INSIDE A SCHOOL BUILDING OR INSIDE A SCHOOL BUS.

19(C)(1)DURING REGULAR SCHOOL HOURS, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT20USE A TOBACCO PRODUCT ON SCHOOL GROUNDS.

(2) OUTSIDE OF REGULAR SCHOOL HOURS, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY
 NOT USE A TOBACCO PRODUCT ON SCHOOL GROUNDS WHEN CHILDREN UNDER
 THE AGE OF 18 YEARS ARE PRESENT.

(D) AN EMPLOYEE OR A VOLUNTEER OF A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM, A
PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL, OR A PRIVATE SCHOOL MAY NOT USE TOBACCO
PRODUCTS AT AN OFF-CAMPUS, SCHOOL-SPONSORED EVENT IN THE PRESENCE
OF STUDENTS.

28 (E) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION:

29 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, SHALL RECEIVE A WARNING AND 30 VERBAL NOTIFICATION OF THE POLICY; AND

1 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A 2 CIVIL PENALTY OF \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

3 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT 4 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 2013.
