20	ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED TO RECEIVE FEES, DUES, OR OTHER PAYMENTS FROM
21	MEMBERS OF A PROFESSION AND DEDICATED FOR USE IN THE REGULATION OR

ACTIVITIES OF THE PROFESSION.

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1	(B) NO PART OF A PROFESSIONAL FUND MAY BE TRANSFERRED OF
2	CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE UNLESS THE TRANSFER OF

4	(1) APPROVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THROUGH
5	LEGISLATION PASSED BY A THREE-FIFTHS MAJORITY VOTE OF:

- 6 (I) THE FULL STANDING COMMITTEE ASSIGNED THE 7 LEGISLATION IN EACH OF THE TWO HOUSES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND
