A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Anne Arundel County – Board of Education – Selection of Members

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain members of the Anne Arundel County 4 Board of Education be elected at certain elections; requiring that certain $\mathbf{5}$ members of the county board be appointed; providing for the residency, the 6 terms of office, and the filling of a vacancy of certain members of the county 7 board; authorizing the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections to adopt certain 8 regulations; providing that a certain member elected to the county board from a 9 certain geographic area but whose district boundaries subsequently are altered may remain as a member of the county board for a certain period of time; 10 providing for the termination of the terms of certain appointed members of the 11 12county board; making certain conforming changes; and generally relating to the Anne Arundel County Board of Education. 13

6 [(f)] (H) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent 7 member of the county board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the 8 legislative district from which the member was appointed **OR ELECTED** may complete 9 the term.

10 **[(g)] (I)** (1) The President of the Anne Arundel County Board of 11 Education is entitled to receive \$8,000 annually as compensation and, except for the 12 student member, the other board members are entitled to receive \$6,000 each 13 annually as compensation.

14 (2) A student member who completes a full term on the board shall be 15 granted a scholarship of \$6,000 to be applied toward the student's higher education 16 costs.

30 (A) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, A MEMBER APPOINTED TO THE 31 COUNTY BOARD BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL BE SELECTED FROM A LIST

1 SUBMITTED TO THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY BY THE SCHOOL BOARD 2 NOMINATING COMMISSION FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY UNDER § 3–110 OF 3 THIS TITLE.

4 (B) THE ELECTED MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE 5 ELECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 8, SUBTITLE 8 OF 6 THE ELECTION LAW ARTICLE GOVERNING THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF 7 COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the 9 appointed members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education for legislative 10 district 32 and for that portion of legislative district 21 that lies within Anne Arundel 11 County, in office on November 30, 2014, shall terminate at the end of November 30, 12 2014, and the terms of appointed members of the Anne Arundel County Board of 13 Education for legislative districts 30, 31, and 33, in office on December 2, 2018, shall 14 terminate at the end of December 2, 2018.
