6 certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to false statements concerning a

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 material, as those terms are defined in § 4-501 of this article.

3 (d) A crime under this section committed using a telephone or other
4 electronic means may be prosecuted **IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH:**

5 (1) [in the county in which] the communication originated; [or]

6 (2) [in the county in which] the communication was received; **OR**

7 **(3) THE DESTRUCTIVE DEVICE OR TOXIC MATERIAL WAS STATED**
8 **OR WAS RUMORED TO BE LOCATED.**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2013.
