- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 19 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 20 (2) "BUSINESS DAY" MEANS A CALENDAR DAY OTHER THAN A 21 SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR LEGAL HOLIDAY.
- 22 (3) "LEGAL HOLIDAY" MEANS:

$\frac{1}{2}$	(I) THE DAY ON WHICH A LEGAL HOLIDAY, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 1, § 27 OF THE CODE, IS OBSERVED; OR
3	(II) A FEDERAL LEGAL HOLIDAY.
4 5 6	[(a)] (B) Unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, a public service company may not establish a new rate or change in rate unless the public service company:
7 8 9	(1) provides to the Commission notice of the new rate or change in rate at least [30] 22 BUSINESS days before the new rate is established or current rate is changed; and
10 11 12	(2) publishes the new rate or change in rate in accordance with § 4–202 of this subtitle during the entire [30] 22 BUSINESS day notice period in new schedules or plainly indicated amendments to existing schedules.
13 14	[(b)] (C) The public service company shall plainly set forth in the notice and publication:
15 16	(1) the changes that it proposes to the rate schedules currently in force; and
17	(2) the effective date of the changes.
18 19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
