$\frac{11}{12}$	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15	(a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
16	(b) "Board" means the State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners.
$17\\18$	(c) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice podiatry.
$\frac{19}{20}$	(d) "Licensed podiatrist" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a podiatrist who is licensed by the Board to practice podiatry.
21	(e) "Podiatrist" means an individual who practices podiatry.

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1 (f) (1) "Practice podiatry" means to diagnose or surgically, medically, or 2 mechanically treat the human foot or ankle, the anatomical structures that attach to 3 the human foot, or the soft tissue below the mid-calf.

4 (2) "Practice podiatry" does not include[:
5 (i) Surgical treatment of acute ankle fracture; or

6 (ii) Administration] ADMINISTRATION of an anesthetic, other 7 than a local anesthetic.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2013.
