A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Video Lottery Gaming – Term of License**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the term of a certain video lottery license; and generally
4 relating to video lottery licenses and the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control
5 Commission.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – State Government**

14 9–1A–07.

15 (f) (1) Except for a video lottery operation license as provided in §
16 9–1A–13 of this subtitle, if satisfied that an applicant is qualified to receive a license,
17 and on tender of all required application, license, and other fees and taxes, and any
18 bond required under § 9–1A–04(e) of this subtitle, the Commission shall issue a license
19 for a term of [3] 5 years.

20 (2) The Commission may stagger the terms of licenses.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 July 1, 2013.
