- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 11 Article State Government
- 12 13–302.
- The Baltimore Oriole (Icterus galbula) [is] AND THE RAVEN (CORVUS CORAX)
- 14 ARE the State [bird] BIRDS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2013.
