- 2 (h) By rules or regulations consistent with the safety and welfare of the 3 traveling public, the Administration may govern the control and use of rest areas, 4 scenic overlooks, roadside picnic areas, and other public use areas within State 5 highway rights—of—way.
- (J) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2013, THE ADMINISTRATION
 SHALL INITIATE THE PROCESS TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO
 PRIVATIZE THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF REST AREAS AND WELCOME
 CENTERS WITHIN STATE HIGHWAY RIGHTS-OF-WAY.
- 10 (2) THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS SHALL INCLUDE PROVISIONS
 11 THAT PROVIDE THAT IN EXCHANGE FOR THE PAYMENT TO THE STATE OF A
 12 LUMP-SUM AMOUNT OR THE PAYMENT OF AN ANNUAL AMOUNT FOR A FIXED
 13 PERIOD, THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER RECEIVES, SUBJECT TO AN AGREEMENT

- 20 (4) ALL MONEY PAID TO THE STATE BY A BIDDER UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 3–216 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 23 (5) FUNDING TO PAY THE COSTS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE 24 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2013.
