3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Mass Transit Trust Fund in the Maryland 4 Department of Transportation; requiring that the Mass Transit Trust Fund be 5 used for certain purposes; requiring the Department to identify and establish a 6 funding source to support the capital and operating expenses for mass transit in 7 the State; prohibiting the Department from using any funds deposited into the 8 Transportation Trust Fund to support the capital and operating costs for mass 9 transit in the State; providing that any funds in the Mass Transit Trust Fund may not revert to or be credited to the general funds of the State or, under 10 certain circumstances, to certain special funds; and generally relating to 11 12 funding for mass transit in the State.

- 23 **3–401.**

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24 (A) THERE IS A MASS TRANSIT TRUST FUND FOR THE DEPARTMENT.



- 1 (B) THE MASS TRANSIT TRUST FUND SHALL BE USED TO SUPPORT 2 MASS TRANSIT IN THE STATE.
- 3 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 4 (1) IDENTIFY AND ESTABLISH A SEPARATE FUNDING SOURCE TO SUPPORT THE EXPENSES FOR MASS TRANSIT IN THE STATE; AND
- 6 (2) DEPOSIT ANY MONEY IDENTIFIED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION INTO THE MASS TRANSIT TRUST FUND.
- 8 (D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT USE ANY MONEY DISTRIBUTED TO THE 9 TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND UNDER § 2–613.1 OF THE TAX GENERAL 10 ARTICLE TO PAY FOR MASS TRANSIT IN THE STATE.
- 11 (E) MONEY FROM THE MASS TRANSIT TRUST FUND MAY BE USED ONLY 12 FOR:
- 13 (1) CAPITAL AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY (WMATA);
- 15 (2) CAPITAL AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE MARYLAND 16 TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION; AND
- 17 (3) GRANTS TO LOCAL JURISDICTIONS FOR MASS TRANSIT 18 CAPITAL AND OPERATING EXPENSES.
- 19 (F) Unless otherwise expressly provided by statute, this 20 section shall be construed to require that the Mass Transit Trust 21 Fund to be the sole source of funding for the capital and operating 22 expenses of the Maryland Transit Administration, the capital and 23 operating expenses of the Washington Metropolitan Transit 24 Authority, and grants to local jurisdictions for mass transit 25 capital and operating expenses.
- 26 (G) (1) NO PART OF THE MASS TRANSIT TRUST FUND MAY REVERT 27 OR BE CREDITED TO:
- 28 (I) THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THIS STATE; OR
- 29 (II) UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, A SPECIAL 30 FUND OF THIS STATE.

- 5 (II) FAILURE OF THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE TO
  6 REJECT THE TRANSFER WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER PRESENTATION BEFORE THE
  7 LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE SHALL BE CONSIDERED TO BE APPROVAL.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2013.
