1 AN ACT concerning

2 Public School Teachers – Certification – Continuing Education

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain county boards of education to establish 4 continuing education criteria for certain teachers and to implement a system for $\mathbf{5}$ verifying completion of certain continuing education requirements; authorizing 6 certain continuing education criteria to include certain courses, roles, activities, 7 preparation, professional development, coaching, advising, or sponsoring; 8 requiring the State Board of Education to monitor the establishment and 9 implementation of certain continuing education requirements; prohibiting the State Board from requiring recertification of certain teachers; and generally 10 relating to continuing education requirements for public school teachers. 11
