HOUSE BILL 950

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 2 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to 3 the salary or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court during a term of office 4 beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning 5 the salary or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court shall take effect at the 6 beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2013.
