Anne Arundel County - School Board - Membership

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain members of the Anne Arundel County 4 Board of Education be elected; requiring that certain members of the county 5 board be appointed; repealing certain provisions relating to a retention election 6 for certain appointed members of the county board; establishing procedures for 7 the election and appointment of certain members of the county board; providing 8 for a nonpartisan election for certain members of the county board under 9 certain circumstances; providing that a certain member elected to the county board from a certain geographic area but whose district boundaries 10 subsequently are altered may remain as a member of the county board for a 11 12 certain period; providing for the termination of the terms of certain members of 13 the county board; and generally relating to contested elections for certain 14 appointed members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education.

- 3 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Governor shall appoint the members of each county board from the residents of that 5 county.

- 10 (ii) The Harford County Board of Education in accordance with 11 § 3–6A–01 of this title;
- 12 (iii) The Caroline County Board of Education in accordance with 13 § 3–3A–02 of this title;
- 14 (iv) The Anne Arundel County Board of Education in accordance 15 with § 3–110 of this subtitle **AND § 3–2A–01 OF THIS TITLE**; and
- 16 (v) The county boards of education in the counties listed in § 3–114 of this subtitle in accordance with the provisions of that section.
- 18 (b) (1) Each member shall be appointed solely because of character and 19 fitness and without regard to political affiliation.
- 20 (2) An individual who is subject to the authority of the county board 21 may not be appointed to or serve on the county board.
- (c) (1) Each member serves for a term of 5 years beginning July 1 after the member's appointment and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 24 (2) The Governor shall appoint a new member to fill any vacancy on 25 an appointed board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed 26 and qualifies.
- 27 (3) Unless otherwise disqualified under this section, a member of a board is eligible for reappointment. However, an individual may not serve for more than 2 consecutive terms.

serve as a member of the county board. At the time of filing a certificate of candidacy

for election to a county board, a person shall certify to the local board of supervisors of

elections whether or not he is subject to the authority of the county board. The

- 1 Governor shall not issue a commission of election to a person who has certified
- 2 affirmatively and who is elected to a county board until the member-elect offers proof
- 3 that he is no longer subject to the authority of the county board.
- 4 **[(e)] (F)** The election of the county boards shall be held as provided in Subtitles 2 through 14 of this title and the Election Law Article.
