A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Public Ethics - Blind Industries and Services of Maryland 3 FOR the purpose of providing that Blind Industries and Services of Maryland is an 4 executive unit under the Maryland Public Ethics Law; providing that an 5 employee or a board member of Blind Industries and Services of Maryland is a public official under the Maryland Public Ethics Law; and generally relating to 6 7 public ethics and Blind Industries and Services of Maryland. 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 9 Article - State Government 10 Section 15-102(m) and 15-103(b)Annotated Code of Maryland 11 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement) 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 Article - State Government 16 15-102."Executive unit" means a department, agency, commission, board, 17 (m) (1) council, or other body of State government that: 18 19 (i) is established by law; and 20 is not in the Legislative Branch or the Judicial Branch of (ii) 21State government. 22 "Executive unit" includes: (2)



1 2 3	(i) a county health department unless the officials and employees of the department are expressly designated as "local officials" in \S 15–807 of this title;
4	(ii) the office of the sheriff in each county;
5	(iii) the office of the State's Attorney in each county; [and]
6	(iv) the Liquor Control Board for Somerset County; AND
7	(V) BLIND INDUSTRIES AND SERVICES OF MARYLAND.

9 10	(b) Except as provided in subsection (f) of this section, the following individuals in executive units are public officials:
11 12 13	(1) an individual who receives compensation at a rate equivalent to at least State grade level 16, or who is appointed to a board, if the Ethics Commission determines under § 15–208 of this title that:
14 15 16	(i) the individual, acting alone or as a member of an executive unit, has decision making authority or acts as a principal advisor to one with that authority:
17	1. in making State policy in an executive unit; or
18 19	2. in exercising quasi-judicial, regulatory, licensing, inspecting, or auditing functions; and
20 21	(ii) the individual's duties are not essentially administrative and ministerial;
22 23 24 25 26	(2) any other individual in an executive unit, if the Ethics Commission determines that the individual, acting alone or as a member of the executive unit, has decision making authority or acts as a principal advisor to one with that authority in drafting specifications for, negotiating, or executing contracts that commit the State or an executive unit to spend more than \$10,000 in a year;
27 28	(3) a member, appointee, or employee of the Maryland Stadium Authority;
29 30	(4) a member, appointee, or employee of the Canal Place Preservation and Development Authority; [and]
31	(5) a member of the Emergency Medical Services Board; AND

- 1 (6) AN EMPLOYEE OR A BOARD MEMBER OF BLIND INDUSTRIES 2 AND SERVICES OF MARYLAND.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2013.
