12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 **10–711.**

16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO THE SALE OF PROPERTY ON WHICH A 17 DWELLING BUILT ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1977, IS LOCATED.

SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, AT LEAST 7 DAYS 18 **(B)** BEFORE SETTLEMENT OF A CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF PROPERTY, A VENDOR 19 20SHALL DELIVER ТО EACH PURCHASER THE RESULTS OF Α 21LEAD-CONTAMINATED DUST TEST PERFORMED FOR THE PROPERTY IN 22ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES AND STANDARDS ADOPTED UNDER § 236-816 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE.
