## Baltimore City _ Video Lottery Operation Lieensen Licensee - Employee Data Collection

FOR the purpose of requiring a certain video lottery operation licensee to compile certain data concerning certain employees and submit the data to the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission on or before a certain date; requiring the Commission to submit a certain report to the General Assembly and certain other persons within a certain time; and generally relating to a certain video lottery operation licensee and the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government
9-1A-01.
(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
(k) "Commission" means the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission.

9-1A-23.
(D) (1) ON OR BEFORE MARGH 31 OF EACH YEAR WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF ITS FIRST YEAR OF OPERATIONS, A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE IN BALTIMORE CITY SHALL:
(I) COMPILE DATA ON THE AGE, SEX, RACE, AND COUNTY OF RESIDENCE OF ITS STATE VIDEO LOTTERY EMPLOYEES O尹 WHO WORKED IN THE STATE DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR; AND
(II) SUBMIT THE DATA TO THE COMMISSION.
(2) WITHIN 3 MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING THE DATA REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT CONTAINING THE DATA TO THE GOVERNOR, THE GOVERNOR'S Office of Minority Affairs, and, SUbJEct TO § 2-1246 of THE State Government Article, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES.
(3) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
