BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – State Government Section 9-1A-01(a) and (k)Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement) BY adding to Article – State Government Section 9-1A-23(d)Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
