## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County – Polling Places – Electioneering Boundaries**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the location of the line beyond which electioneering is  
4 prohibited outside a polling place in Washington County; and generally relating  
5 to electioneering at a polling place in Washington County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Election Law**

19 16–206.

20 (b) (1) At each polling place, one election judge from each principal  
21 political party shall be designated by the local board and, acting jointly, shall post  
22 signs delineating a line around the entrance and exit of the building that are closest to  
23 that part of the building in which voting occurs.
