- 20 (1) THE PATIENT RECEIVES ON-SITE SERVICES FROM THE

- 4 (3) THE PATIENT IS CLASSIFIED AS AN OUTPATIENT AT THE 5 HOSPITAL FOR OBSERVATION RATHER THAN AN ADMITTED INPATIENT.
- 6 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT BY REGULATION STANDARD LANGUAGE FOR THE WRITTEN NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2013.
