"Board" means the Prince George's County Board of License 1 **(2)** 2 Commissioners. "Commission" means the Maryland-National Capital Park and 3 (3)4 Planning Commission. The Board may issue special 7-day Class B-GC (golf course)  $\mathbf{5}$ (b) 6 on-sale beer and wine licenses for the exclusive use on the premises of the 7 Commission's golf courses located within Prince George's County. 8 (2) The special 7-day Class B-GC on-sale beer and wine license authorizes the holder to sell beer and wine from 1 or more outlets for consumption on 9 10 the premises of the golf course. (3) 11 (i) A separate license is required for each applicable golf course. 12 (ii) A special 7-day Class B-GC on-sale beer and wine license 13 shall be issued to each of the managers of the Commission's golf courses upon making application and qualifying as a license holder under this article. 14 15 **(4)** Except as provided in this subsection, the hours of sale for beer and wine under this license are from [11 a.m.] 9 A.M. to 10 p.m. daily, Monday 16 through Sunday. 17 18 The Commission may: (ii) 19 1. Reduce the hours of sale of beer and wine under this license; and 20 212. Discontinue the sale of beer and wine under this 22license from Labor Day through Memorial Day. 23 (5)The annual fee for a special 7-day Class B-GC on-sale beer and 24wine license is \$365.
