2 **Prince George's County Public Schools – Certificated Professional**
3 **Individuals – Termination of Employment**

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certificated professional individual who is employed
6 by the Prince George's County Board of Education to terminate a contract of
7 employment by giving certain notice to the board of education no later than a
8 certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to
9 the termination of employment by certificated professional individuals in Prince
10 George's County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Education**

19 **3–1008.**

20 **NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW OR REGULATION, IN**
21 **PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, A CERTIFICATED PROFESSIONAL INDIVIDUAL WHO**
22 **IS EMPLOYED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD MAY TERMINATE A**
23 **CONTRACT OF EMPLOYMENT BY GIVING NOTICE IN WRITING TO THE PRINCE**
24 **GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD:**

1 **(1) IF THE INDIVIDUAL WAS HIRED BEFORE JANUARY 1, NOT**
2 **LATER THAN MAY 1 AT THE END OF THE FIRST, SECOND, OR THIRD SCHOOL**
3 **YEAR OF EMPLOYMENT; OR**

4 **(2) IF THE INDIVIDUAL WAS HIRED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, NOT**
5 **LATER THAN MAY 1 IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE FIRST, SECOND, OR THIRD**
6 **ANNIVERSARY DATE OF EMPLOYMENT.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 July 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30,
9 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
10 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
