19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

3 (r) (8) (i) There is a Class BCE license.

4 (ii) The annual license fee is \$3,630.

5 (iii) The Board may issue a special Class B on–sale beer, wine
6 and liquor license to be known as Class BCE which shall be issued only to catering
7 establishments.8 (iv) A catering establishment shall be defined by the regulations
9 of the Board which shall require that:10 1. The catering establishment have a minimum capital
11 investment of \$500,000 for dining room facilities and kitchen equipment. This sum
12 may not include the cost of land, buildings, or a lease; and

13 2. A minimum seating capacity of 150 persons.

14 (v) The Board shall prescribe regulations pertaining to the
15 hours and days of sale.

16 (vi) Food shall be served with alcoholic beverages.

17 (vii) A Class BCE license is limited and restricted to the purpose
18 of providing alcoholic beverages for consumption on the licensed premises by
19 participants of catered events only, and off–sale privileges may not be exercised.20 (18) (i) There is a Class B–AE (arts and entertainment) beer, wine
21 and liquor license.22 (ii) A Class B–AE license may be issued only to an
23 establishment in the Prince George’s County arts and entertainment district as
24 approved by the County Council in Council Resolution CR–83–2001.25 (iii) The license authorizes the holder to sell beer, wine, and
26 liquor for consumption on the licensed premises only.

27 (iv) A person may not hold more than 2 Class B–AE licenses.

28 (v) The annual license fee is \$2,750.

29 (vi) The Board of License Commissioners shall adopt regulations
30 to carry out this paragraph, including regulations specifying hours and days of sale.

2 (a) This section applies only in Prince George’s County.
