A BILL ENTITLED

Public Schools and Youth Sports Programs – Girls Lacrosse – Protective
 Head Gear

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to require certain 5 girls lacrosse youth sports programs to require certain athletes to wear 6 protective head gear during practices and games; requiring a recreational 7 athletic organization that operates a girls lacrosse youth sports program to 8 require certain athletes to wear protective head gear during practices and 9 games; requiring a local government to provide a certain notice to certain operators of a girls lacrosse youth sports program under certain circumstances; 10 authorizing a local government to withhold a certain permit under certain 11 12circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to protective head 13 gear and girls lacrosse youth sports programs.

WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates that as many as 3,999,000 sports—related and recreation—related concussions occur in the

27 United States each year; and



- WHEREAS, Head and facial injuries are one of the most commonly reported types of injuries in children and adolescents who participate in sports and recreational activities; and
- WHEREAS, A concussion is a type of brain injury that may range from mild to severe and can disrupt the way the brain normally works; and
- 6 WHEREAS, A head or facial injury may occur during organized and 7 unorganized sports and recreational activities as a result of falls or players colliding 8 with each other, other obstacles, or the ground; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Young girls are at a greater risk of head or facial injuries from participation in girls lacrosse; now, therefore,
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 16 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 17 (2) "GIRLS LACROSSE YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM" MEANS A
 18 LACROSSE PROGRAM ORGANIZED FOR THE RECREATIONAL ATHLETIC
 19 COMPETITION OR INSTRUCTION OF GIRLS WHO ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 19.
- 20 (3) "PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR" MEANS A HELMET THAT 21 COMPLIES WITH THE DESIGN AND PROTECTIVE STANDARDS SET FORTH BY THE 22 CONCUSSION TASK FORCE.
- 23 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE A GIRLS LACROSSE YOUTH
 24 SPORTS PROGRAM OPERATED BY A COUNTY BOARD OR PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE
 25 STATE TO REQUIRE EACH ATHLETE TO WEAR PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR DURING
 26 PRACTICES AND GAMES.

- 29 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 30 MEANINGS INDICATED.

- 1 (2) "GIRLS LACROSSE YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM" MEANS A LACROSSE PROGRAM ORGANIZED FOR THE RECREATIONAL ATHLETIC 3 COMPETITION OR INSTRUCTION OF GIRLS WHO ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 19.
- 4 (3) "PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR" MEANS A HELMET THAT 5 COMPLIES WITH THE DESIGN AND PROTECTIVE STANDARDS SET FORTH BY THE 6 CONCUSSION TASK FORCE.
- 7 (B) A RECREATIONAL ATHLETIC ORGANIZATION THAT OPERATES A 8 GIRLS LACROSSE YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM SHALL REQUIRE EACH ATHLETE TO 9 WEAR PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR DURING PRACTICES AND GAMES.
- 10 (C) BEFORE A GIRLS LACROSSE YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM MAY USE A
 11 FACILITY OWNED OR OPERATED BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE LOCAL
 12 GOVERNMENT SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE OPERATOR OF THE GIRLS
 13 LACROSSE YOUTHS SPORTS PROGRAM OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
 14 SECTION.
- 15 (D) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY WITHHOLD A FACILITY USE PERMIT
 16 FROM A RECREATIONAL ATHLETIC ORGANIZATION THAT OPERATES A GIRLS
 17 LACROSSE YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAM FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE
 18 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
