- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Prince George's County Health Department to 5 establish and implement a system for grading and classifying health inspection 6 results for certain food service facilities in Prince George's County; requiring the 7 Health Department to provide certain food service facilities with letter grade 8 cards; requiring food service facilities to immediately post letter grade cards 9 under certain circumstances; prohibiting the Health Department from providing 10 a letter grade card to a food service facility if the Health Department orders the 11 closing of the facility; prohibiting a letter grade card from being defaced, 12 marred, camouflaged, or hidden from public view; requiring certain food service facilities to post letter grade cards in a conspicuous manner; requiring the 13 Health Department to conduct second inspections of certain food service 14 15 facilities under certain circumstances; authorizing certain food service facilities to request certain hearings to contest certain letter grades; authorizing a food 16 17 service facility to defer posting a letter grade card pending the results of a 18 subsequent inspection; requiring a food service facility to remove a letter grade 19 card and post a sign provided by the Health Department advising the public of 20 certain information regarding the inspection of the facility; requiring the Prince 21 George's County Health Officer to regrade certain inspection results and issue 22 new letter grade cards under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and 23 generally relating to the grading of health inspection results for food service 24facilities in Prince George's County.

- 14 POST A LETTER GRADE CARD SO THAT IT IS VISIBLE TO THE PUBLIC AND TO

- 16 (2) A LETTER GRADE CARD MAY NOT BE DEFACED, MARRED,

- 9 CONDUCTED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER TO
- 10 CONTEST THE LETTER GRADE.
- 11 (II) THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY MAY DEFER POSTING THE
- 12 LETTER GRADE CARD PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNTIL 72 HOURS AFTER
- 13 THE HEARING.
- 14 (III) IF A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY CHOOSES TO DEFER
- 15 POSTING A LETTER GRADE CARD AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF
- 16 THIS PARAGRAPH, THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY SHALL REMOVE ANY LETTER
- 17 GRADE CARD THAT IS CURRENTLY POSTED AND CONSPICUOUSLY POST A SIGN
- 18 PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT SO THAT IT IS VISIBLE TO THE PUBLIC AND TO
- 19 PATRONS BEFORE THE PATRONS ENTER THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY.
- 20 (IV) THE SIGN SHALL ADVISE THE PUBLIC THAT:
- 21 THE INSPECTION RESULTS OF THE FOOD SERVICE
- 22 FACILITY ARE UNDER REVIEW; AND
- 23 2. The results of the inspection may be
- 24 OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- 25 (V) WITHIN 72 HOURS AFTER THE HEARING, THE PRINCE
- 26 GEORGE'S COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER SHALL REGRADE THE INSPECTION
- 27 RESULTS, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT ANY SUBSEQUENT INSPECTION OF THE FOOD
- 28 SERVICE FACILITY THAT RESULTS IN A FINDING THAT THE FOOD SERVICE
- 29 FACILITY COMPLIES WITH STATE AND LOCAL HEALTH LAWS.
- 30 (VI) IF REGRADING CHANGES THE INSPECTION GRADE, THE
- 31 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY A NEW LETTER GRADE
- 32 CARD THAT THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY SHALL IMMEDIATELY POST.

1	(VII) IF REGRADING DOES NOT CHANGE THE INSPECTION
2	GRADE, THE FOOD SERVICE FACILITY SHALL IMMEDIATELY POST THE LETTER
3	GRADE CARD ISSUED AFTER THE SECOND INSPECTION AS PROVIDED UNDER
4	PARAGRAPH (4)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2013.
