1 (2) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, "proceeds" 2 does not include money given away by a video lottery operation licensee as free 3 promotional play and used by players to bet in a video lottery terminal **OR AT A** 4 **TABLE GAME**.

5 (ii) After the first fiscal year of operations, the exclusion 6 specified in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph may not exceed a percentage 7 established by the Commission by regulation of the proceeds received from video 8 lottery terminals AND TABLE GAMES in the prior fiscal year by the video lottery 9 operation licensee under § 9–1A–27(a)(2), [and] (c)(1)(ii), AND (D)(1) of this subtitle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2013.
