A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Educator Evaluation System – Pilot Program Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to extend the pilot
4 program for the Educator Evaluation System until certain assessments are
5 aligned with the Maryland Common Core State Curriculum and the
6 assessments are fully implemented; requiring the Department to take the steps
7 necessary to implement a certain requirement; and generally relating to an
8 extension of the Educator Evaluation System pilot program.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
10 MARYLAND, That:

11 (a) The State Department of Education shall extend the pilot program for the
12 Educator Evaluation System established under § 6–202 of the Education Article until
13 State assessments are aligned with the Maryland Common Core State Curriculum
14 and the assessments are fully implemented.

15 (b) The State Department of Education shall take the steps necessary to
16 implement the requirements of this section.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 June 1, 2013.
