## Criminal Law - Drive-By Shooting - Forfeiture of Motor Vehicle

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person, while in or having just exited a motor vehicle, from recklessly discharging a firearm at or toward another motor vehicle or building or at or toward another person or an occupied building or motor vehicle; requiring the forfeiture of a certain motor vehicle, subject to certain requirements; and generally relating to discharging firearms from motor vehicles.

- 18 (A) A PERSON, WHILE IN OR HAVING JUST EXITED A MOTOR VEHICLE, 19 MAY NOT RECKLESSLY DISCHARGE A FIREARM AT OR TOWARD ANOTHER MOTOR
- 20 VEHICLE, A BUILDING, OR ANOTHER PERSON.
- 21 (B) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A MOTOR VEHICLE
- 22 UNLESS THE OWNER AUTHORIZED OR ALLOWED THE VEHICLE TO BE USED OR
- 23 EMPLOYED IN DISCHARGING A FIREARM DURING THE COURSE OF A VIOLATION

4	JURISDICTION INITIATED THE INVESTIGATION.

- 5 (3) If A COURT ORDERS FORFEITURE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, 6 THE INTEREST TRANSFERRED TO THE STATE OR COUNTY IS SUBORDINATE TO 7 THE INTEREST OF THE HOLDER OF A PERFECTED SECURITY INTEREST IN THE 8 MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 9 (4) (I) AFTER DISCHARGING ANY PERFECTED SECURITY 10 INTEREST IN A FORFEITED MOTOR VEHICLE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE 11 POLICE OR THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY MAY:
- 2. SELL, EXCHANGE, OR CONVEY THE FORFEITED MOTOR VEHICLE.
- (II) ANY MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE SALE, EXCHANGE, OR
  CONVEYANCE UNDER PARAGRAPH (I)2 OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE
  DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE OR THE GENERAL FUND OF
  THE COUNTY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
