- 12 (3) AS APPLICABLE, USE THE 1828 EDITION OF WEBSTER'S 13 DICTIONARY WHEN DEFINING TERMS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
